<p>I know the proposal can only be 15 pages, but can we have 4 dividers for the 4 sections? If that is the case, I am assuming that dividers will not count as pages. Please let me know if that is acceptable.</p>	<p>Dividers will not count as pages as long as they do not contain content (text, pictures, graphic, etc.) other than what is necessary to identify the section of the proposal.</p>
<p>The RFP indicates that SCOG has a budget of up to \$30,000 available for this project. Appendix A of the RFP indicates a grant agreement with WSDOT for \$60,000 to develop this plan. Will SCOG consider proposals to develop the coordinated plan for more than \$30,000, or would a proposed budget above \$30,000 effectively disqualify a proposal?</p>	<p>Only \$30,000 is budgeted by SCOG for a professional services contract. Proposals should be at or under this figure.</p> <p>The remaining funds from the WSDOT agreement are planned for project administration, technical support, public outreach and implementation after plan adoption.</p>
<p>If the maximum \$30,000 contract budget is firm, would SCOG staff resources be available to assist with the outreach efforts or other task efforts?</p>	<p>Yes, SCOG staff will be available to assist with outreach efforts and other tasks. Additionally, Island County staff will be available as well.</p> <p>Staffs are in the process of setting up an 11 member special needs transportation committee that will also assist with this planning effort.</p>
