

RESOLUTION 2017-01

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE SKAGIT POPULATION, EMPLOYMENT AND HOUSING GROWTH MONITORING PROGRAM: 2017 BASELINE GROWTH MONITORING REPORT

WHEREAS, the 2002 Framework Agreement – executed by Skagit County and all cities and towns in Skagit County, except Lyman – established a planning organization known as the GMA Committee, which consists of a Steering Committee (GMASC) and a Technical Advisory Committee (Planners Committee);

WHEREAS, through the 2002 Framework Agreement process, the Board of Skagit County Commissioners amended Countywide Planning Policy 1 (CPP 1) on June 30, 2016;

WHEREAS, the 2016 amendment to CPP 1 introduced a long term monitoring process requirement for annual population and employment growth allocations;

WHEREAS, CPP 1: Appendix B, Section 3.b directs the Planners Committee to develop and recommend an annual growth monitoring report;

WHEREAS, the Planners Committee recommended the first annual growth monitoring report for GMASC approval at their December 12, 2017 meeting;

WHEREAS, the first annual growth monitoring report is titled the “Skagit Population, Employment and Housing Growth Monitoring Program: 2017 Baseline Growth Monitoring Report”; and

WHEREAS, CPP 1: Appendix B, Section 3.c directs the Steering Committee to review and approve the annual report by resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Growth Management Act Steering Committee hereby approves the Skagit Population, Employment and Housing Growth Monitoring Program: 2017 Baseline Growth Monitoring Report.
