NON-MOTORIZED ADVISORY COMMITTEE 2023 Work Program

Every year, the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) reviews and approves the work program for the Non-Motorized Advisory Committee (NMAC). The NMAC is an advisory committee to the TAC. This process for work program recommendation and approval is described in the NMAC bylaws.

The TAC approved the Non-Motorized Advisory Committee 2023 Work Program at its December 1, 2022 meeting.

1. Biannual Update to Technical Advisory Committee

Per the NMAC Bylaws that were adopted on January 7, 2016, the NMAC is required to report on progress twice a year to the TAC in June and December.

Products: An NMAC member will brief the TAC biannually, in June and December of 2023.

2. Provide Technical Input to the TAC on Project Selection Criteria and Ranking

The Transportation Policy Board is anticipated to select projects for Surface Transportation Block Grant Program and Transportation Alternatives in the second quarter of calendar year 2023. The TAC provides advice to the Transportation Policy Board on the selection process and the NMAC is available to provide advice to the TAC as necessary. This project selection is anticipated to begin at the end of 2022.

Products: Input to the TAC on non-motorized aspects of the project selection process for Surface Transportation Block Grant Program and Transportation Alternatives in early 2023.

3. Review NMAC Bylaws and Recommend Updates to TAC

Since the adoption of the NMAC Bylaws in January 2016, there have been several changes that may necessitate amending the committee's bylaws. In 2023 the NMAC will review the committee's bylaws, to include Meetings, Membership, Responsibilities and Leadership.

Products: Revised bylaws approved by the TAC.

4. Assist Member Organizations and Volunteer Groups to Improve Non-motorized Transportation and Safety

Provide a non-motorized transportation resource to the member organizations of SCOG and volunteer groups that are actively involved with non-motorized transportation in Skagit County.

Products: no specific products have yet been identified for this work program item, but products may be added later in 2023.

No further activities were recommended by the NMAC for their 2023 work program.
