#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Skagit Council of Governments (SCOG) staff and Technical Advisory Committee recommend approval of the following Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) amendments:

- Concrete
  - School Secondary Access: this amendment revises a project already programmed in the RTIP. The amendment moves all secured funding for the project's construction phase to 2029 to maintain overall fiscal constraint in the 2025–2028 program years. SCOG staff anticipates the funding will be reprogrammed in the 2026–2031 RTIP, which is scheduled for adoption October 15, 2025.
- Skagit Council of Governments
  - SCOG Administration: this amendment revises a project already programmed in the RTIP. The amendment moves all secured funding for the project to 2029–2030 to maintain overall fiscal constraint in the 2025–2028 program years. SCOG staff anticipates the funding will be reprogrammed in the 2026–2031 RTIP, which is scheduled for adoption October 15, 2025.

### **FISCAL CONSTRAINT**

Regional Transportation Improvement Program is fiscally constrained in the 2025–2028 program years.

#### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

A public comment period began on August 29 and ended on September 5.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE MODIFICATIONS**

Administrative modifications to the Regional Transportation Improvement Program do not require Transportation Policy Board approval, and are submitted to the Washington State Department of Transportation along with any amendments for the month. Administrative modifications are provided below for informational purposes only.

- Sedro-Woolley
  - o John Liner Road Arterial Improvements: this administrative modification revises a project already programmed in the RTIP. Sedro-Woolley staff moved forward the right-of-way

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phase for this project earlier in 2025, placing the phase on the 2025 Obligation Authority Plan, consistent with Obligation Authority Procedures. Due to a project delay, the phase will be unable to obligate federal funding prior to the October 1, 2025 deadline, as required, so will be removed from the RTIP by SCOG staff per Obligation Authority Procedures. An appeal may be made to the Transportation Policy Board to reprogram the federal funds for this phase in the future, consistent with Obligation Authority Procedures.
